Kalamazoo Micro-Enterprise Grants

United Way of the Battle Creek and Kalamazoo Region, in partnership with the City of Kalamazoo with support from Foundation for Excellence and Consumers Energy, launched Kalamazoo Micro-Enterprise Grants in 2020 with an aim to bring relief to those hit hardest by the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic. First priority was given to businesses owned by Black, Indigenous, and People of Color. Additional priority was given to women-owned businesses and those located within Shared Prosperity Kalamazoo neighborhoods of Eastside, Edison and Northside. In 2020, 116 businesses applied, and 100 received grants of \$5,000 each. Continued support from the city's Foundation For Excellence allowed for a 2021 round to support an additional 90 business, and a spring 2022 round that awarded grants to 60 more.




Neighborhoods of Awarded Grantees




